ONLINE DRUG & ALCOHOL ASSESSMENTS/EVALUATIONS

Below is how you would start a Drug and Alcohol Evaluation with our facility. No paper packets will be available.

- ✚ First, contact our office to start an electronic chart. (Demographic Information)
- ✚ You will need to provide a valid email address.
- ✚ We will email you the link to our website the "Client Portal," and you will then be given a username and password to access that website.
- ✚ You will need to upload a picture of your proof of tribal enrollment, valid photo ID and any insurance you may have to our "Client Portal" website. Then contact our office and let us know that they have been uploaded.
- ✚ After you have provided the required documents, we will then send you all the evaluation forms for you to complete to our website. Then contact the office.
- ✚ We will schedule you for an online video evaluation or an in-person evaluation.

INTENSIVE OUTPATIENT TREATMENT CLASSES (IOP)-ONSITE

If you are continuing care from a different facility for IOP Treatment you will have to provide your recent full evaluation, discharge summary, proof of tribal enrollment and a valid photo ID. Forms will need to be completed before treatment can start. This is an 8-week treatment coinciding with individual sessions once a week with the instructor. Attendance is mandatory and appreciated. A waiting list is often implemented and can be lengthy.

INDIVIDUAL SESSIONS

Weekly 1 hour per individual

AFTERCARE GROUP—ONLINE SESSIONS

Treatment will be held through Online Zoom Group Tuesday's from 1:00 pm-2:00 pm. An Aftercare Treatment Plan and forms will need to be completed for this treatment. Waiting lists sometimes apply to this treatment and can be lengthy. To continue care from another facility, you will need to provide your full evaluation, discharge summary, proof of tribal enrollment and valid photo ID.

Tuesday's 1:00 pm-2:00 pm Online Zoom Class

DUI/DWI CLASSES— CONDUCTED ONSITE

You will need to provide proof of tribal enrollment, a valid photo ID, and valid email address. We will also issue you a username and password for our Client Portal Website for DUI forms to complete. Paperwork will need to be completed online prior to the course date. A DUI workbook will be given to you on your first day of class. *Both classes are located at our facility and are from 9:00 am-3:00 pm.

2 Six-hour classes each month to equal 12-hour required course hours

You will need to be present for the first scheduled class to attend the second class to receive your DUI completion certificate. No exceptions.

CODEPENDENCY TREATMENT-ONSITE

Codependency will be a weeklong treatment located at our facility. Dates for this treatment will be announced soon.

You will need to provide the following:

- ✚ Proof of Tribal Enrollment & Valid Photo ID
- ✚ Insurance is requested but not needed to attend
- ✚ Complete a Co-Dependency Application
- ✚ Complete Co-Dependency forms once accepted
